**JESUS, THERE IS NO OTHER LIKE HIM**  
**He Makes Fishers of Men**  
**Mark 1:16-20 & Luke 5:1-11**

<sup>5</sup> The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and they were baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. **(Mark 1:5)**

<sup>7</sup> He proclaimed, "One who is more powerful than I am coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the strap of his sandals. <sup>8</sup> I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." **(Mark 1:8)**

**JESUS IS SUPERIOR TO JOHN THE BAPTIST:**

- **IN HIS PERSON.**
- **IN HIS WORK.**

<sup>15</sup> Jesus answered him, "Allow it for now, because this is the way for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then John allowed him to be baptized. **(Mateo 3:15)**

<sup>12</sup> Immediately the Spirit drove him into the wilderness. <sup>13</sup> He was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. He was with the wild animals, and the angels were serving him. **(Mark 1:12-13)**

**I - JESUS HAS CALLED ME TO MAKE ME A FISHER OF MEN.**

<sup>16</sup> As he passed alongside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew, Simon's brother, casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. **(Mark 1:16)**

**1 Corinthians 1:26-30**

<sup>26</sup> Brothers and sisters, consider your calling: Not many were wise from a human perspective, not many powerful, not many of noble birth. <sup>27</sup> Instead, God has chosen what is foolish in the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen what is weak in the world to shame the strong. <sup>28</sup> God has chosen what is insignificant and despised in the world—what is viewed as nothing—to bring to nothing what is viewed as something, <sup>29</sup> so that no one may boast in his presence.

<sup>18</sup> Immediately they left their nets and followed him. (**Mark 1:18**)

<sup>11</sup> So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him. (**Luke 5:11**)

### **III – BY THE POWER OF CHRIST, I WILL BE A FISHER OF MEN.**

<sup>17</sup> “Follow me,” Jesus told them, “and **I will make you** fish for people.”

#### **Luke 5: 1 – 11**

So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, <sup>2</sup> and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing *their* nets. <sup>3</sup> Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon’s, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat.

<sup>4</sup> When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, “Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.”

<sup>5</sup> But Simon answered and said to Him, “Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net.” <sup>6</sup> And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. <sup>7</sup> So they signaled to *their* partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. <sup>8</sup> When Simon Peter saw *it*, he fell down at Jesus’ knees, saying, “Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!”

<sup>9</sup> For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; <sup>10</sup> and so also *were* James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, “Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men.” <sup>11</sup> So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.
